Please note

KF can play an essential role in the lanthanide cryptate protection by preventing the action of possible quenchers contained in the assay. KF is mandatory for HTRF assays using Europium cryptate. KF is generally used at a final concentration of 100 to 400 mM, and is added to the conjugate working solutions or dispensed in a separate step, just before the readout.

Once thawed, to avoid freeze/thaw cycles, it is recommended to dispense remaining stock solutions into disposable plastic vials (aliquots should not be under 10µL) for storage at -20°C or below.
